The Parent Council exists to provide a formal link between the school and the Parent Forum (the official name for all parents and carers who have children at the school). It operates separately from the Parent and Staff Association (PSA), which encourages the Parent Forum to be involved in practically supporting the school's activities and fundraising.

Parent Councils were created by the Scottish Schools (Parental Involvement)
Act 2006 and have a formal role in working with the school. Connect

that seeks to make parental involvement and family engagement in education

The Parent Council is elected by the Parent Forum at its AGM every year and includes a number of office bearers, reps for each year group, reps covering specific areas such as Additional Support Needs. The Head Teacher and other staff, as well as the local councillors for our area, are also invited to attend the meetings. Meetings are open to all members of the Parent Forum to attend.
