School dinners & Racked lunches




The school lunches and packed lunches used to be divided, apart from the odd pack lunches in the school lunch hall, but that got dealt with quickly and now we can all sit together when we please!

Current School Roll

A little bit of movement but Blackhall currently has a roll of 370 pupils.

Average class size is 24.7 pupils.

P1 and P2 remain the only stages that are full. (P3 - only 3 spaces in the year group)

We are dropping a class for next session, 2025-26 and dropping roll (around 350, we hope...).

 Ashcroft in the office as if we could!


- Megan McKinney has officially resigned her post with CEC.

Money and stuff...




- Staffing is our greatest cost. We have had some absence in both teaching and support staff.

- If it drops, we are cut by a further £24k (approx.)



- We continue to ask for no mobile phones in school or playground and continue to teach our children about staying safe online.




Sports and Activities




- Our First Week Back, we are inviting parents and carers to come in and share the learning in your child's class.
