## 1 Welcome and Apologies

## 2 Annual Report from the Chairs

## 2.1 Annual Report from the PCC Chair

The Chair expressed her thanks to all members of the PCC, who have turned up full of enthusiasm and fully participated with the meetings this year. We've had good debate, challenging conversations and have made a difference on a number of different topics this year. Some topics were discussed more frequently than others.



The Chair provided a short update on developments regarding grants from the last couple of weeks. Blackhall Childrens Sports Committee has confirmed a generous award towards to the playground works.

Grow Your Own Fund, have recommended our project application for full funding. Watch this space for further development with growing fruit.

Community Grants Fund, have recommended a full award to support the pond development. The Tool Shed at HMP Edinburgh. are donating refurbished garden tools to school.

A year rep was able to update that a group from Adobe are coming into school to support some grounds maintenance. A group from RBS are coming into school in August to paint the building. [Post Meeting Note: Johnstone's at Blackhall have donated masonry paint.] There is also the potential for a local artist to paint some murals on the walls. This is going to be investigated in conjunction with the pupils next term.

### 2.2 Annual Report from the PSA Chair

The Chair thanked all the reps for their hardwork this year. This was another successful year where significant sums of money have been raised, allowing the PSA to support a range of things in school. The Chair noted that the collaborative working with the PCC on the playground fundraising has been a real positive and has led to much better joint up working. This has allowed accessing other funding streams that wouldn't traditionally have been used.

The PSA started the year with an event plan and achieved the plan -well done to all involved. Event included

Next year, it would be good to aim towards working more closely with the school on events and reaching more parents/ families with social events.
