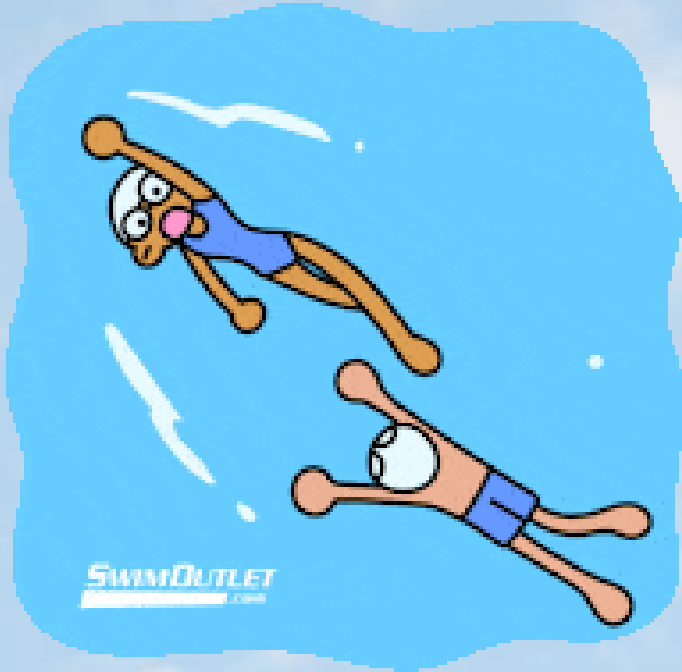


# Tuesday, 16<sup>th</sup> September is International Day for the Preservation of the Ozone Layer!

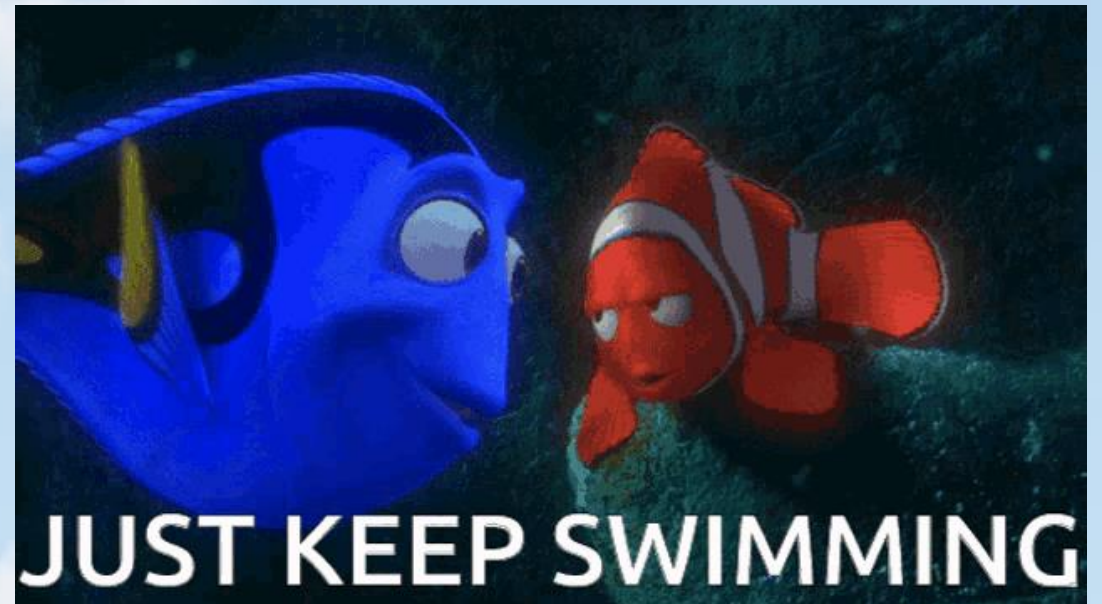


- The Ozone layer protects the Earth from the sun's harmful rays.
