- The dish was named after his nickname and it wasn't long before “nachos” became a household term.

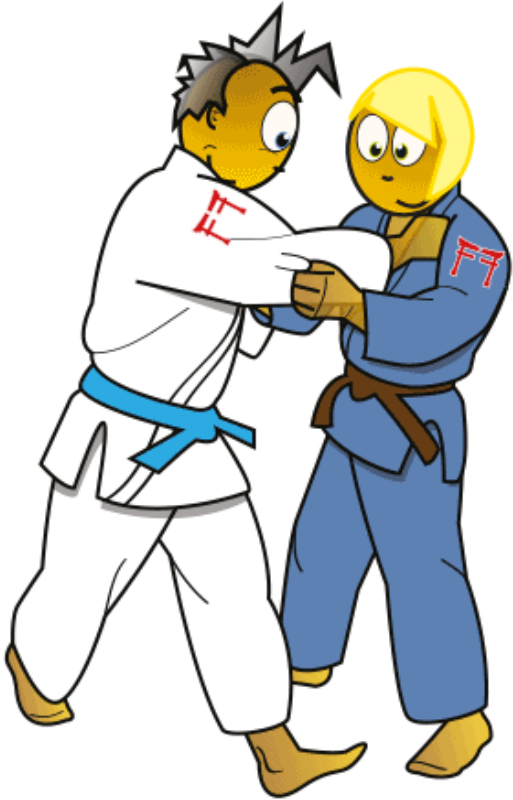
