Thursday, 6th November is National Saxophone Day

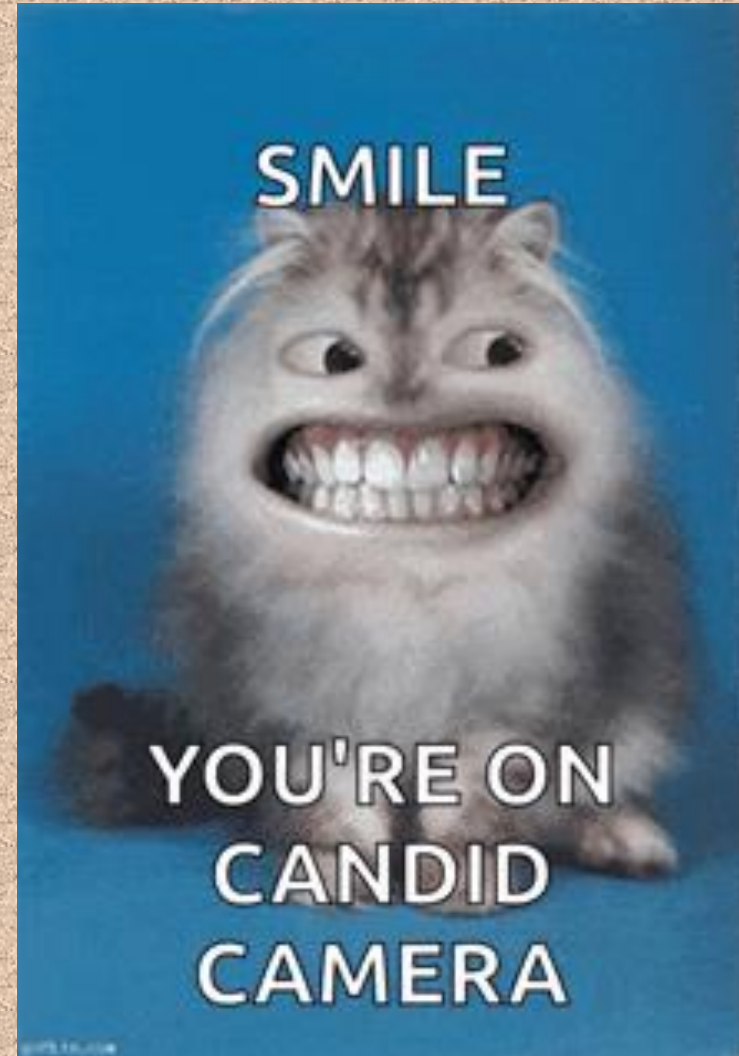


- The Saxophone is a woodwind instrument that was developed by a Belgian instrument designer by the name of Adolphe Sax in 1846.
