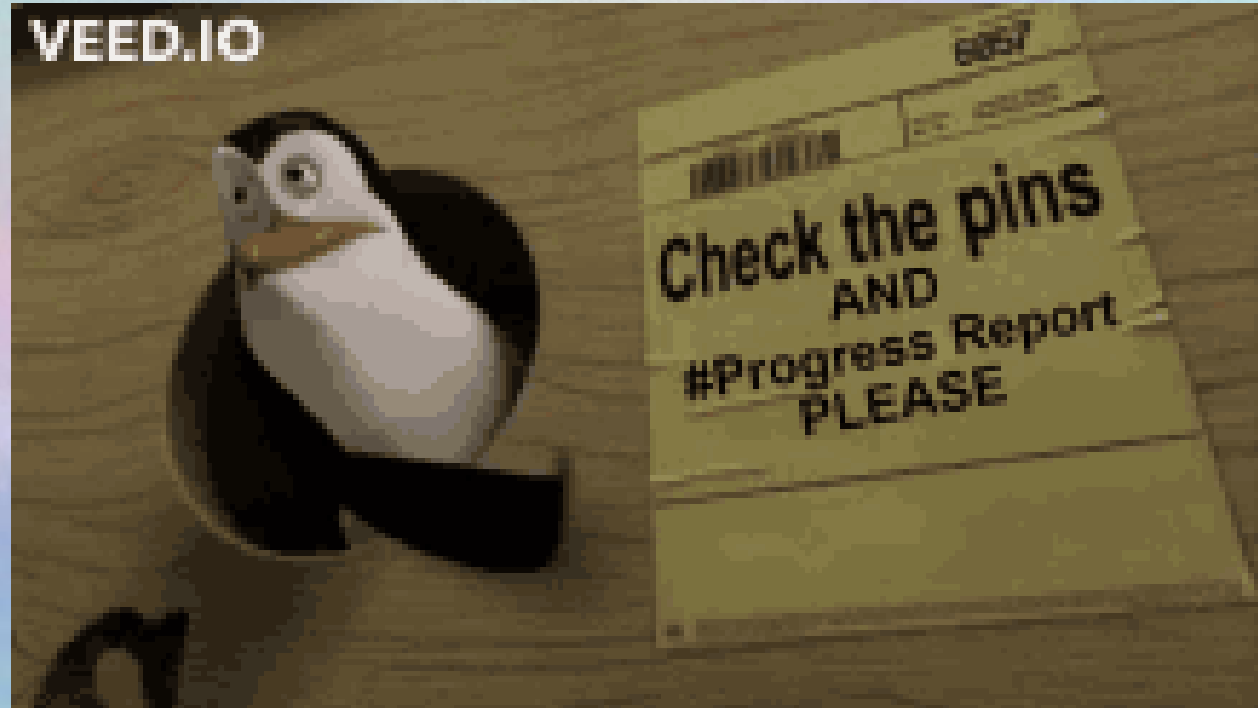


Parent Carer Council Head Teacher Report

P7 trip to Robotarium June 2025

Price was £2 per pupil.

51/66 children paid.

Shortfall - around **£30**

P6 & P7 trip to Usherhall June 2025

Price was £2.35 per pupil.

Shortfall - around **£50**

Royal Highland Show trip June 2025

Price was £6.50 per pupil.

205/251 children paid.

Shortfall - **£210**



Panto – December 2025

Price was set at £15.50 per pupil.

PSA and PCC subsidy contribution of £1,000

School paid deposit of £1,200.

Shortfall - around **£800**

- Any expertise and spare time? Please contact school!

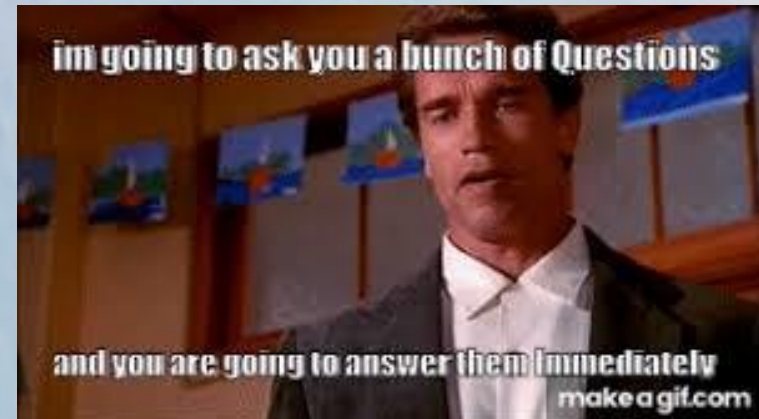
Parking!

- No timescale shared on when this will be actioned.

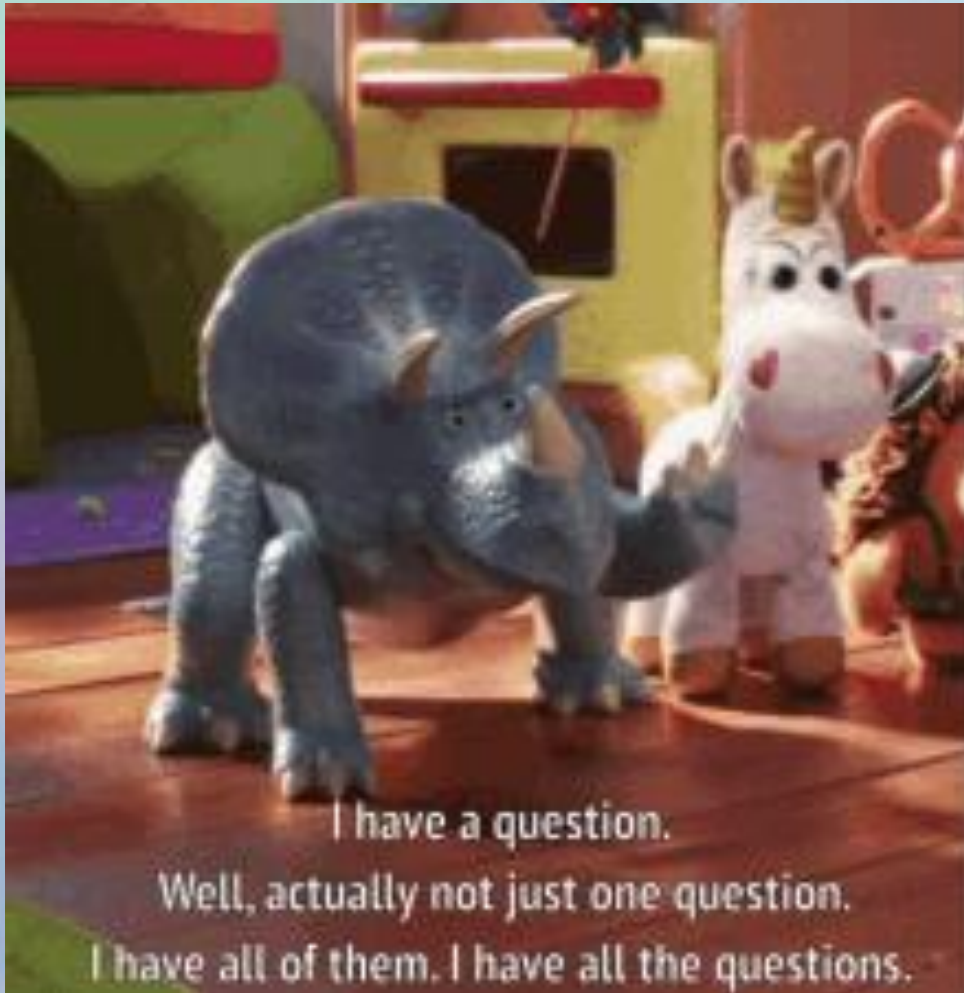


Questions

- 1. Have the lights in the big hall been replaced with LED lighting now? Understand that this was the only area not with LED and was due to be replaced.
- 2. Parents not being told their child is getting additional support and not getting any feedback on any of this. Something similar has come up about children being removed from nurture groups without parents being made aware. Communication would always be appreciated here, especially for additional support so parents have more sense of how they can help at home.
- 3. Breathing exercises for all in class to help with overwhelm and anxiety - this could allow those that get overwhelmed and need this to not stand out as much and would be helpful for everyone (this may already happen but worth being aware either way).
- 4. Training in neurodiverse behaviours and how to deal with this for all staff (this is not pointing fingers at all but has come from a few incidents where the staff possibly weren't aware of stimming behaviour etc).
- 5. Age-appropriate tools and distractions for children when taken out of class to regulate (bubbles for a 10-year-old were mentioned).

Not replaced with LED yet. Due to be replaced in the summer holidays.

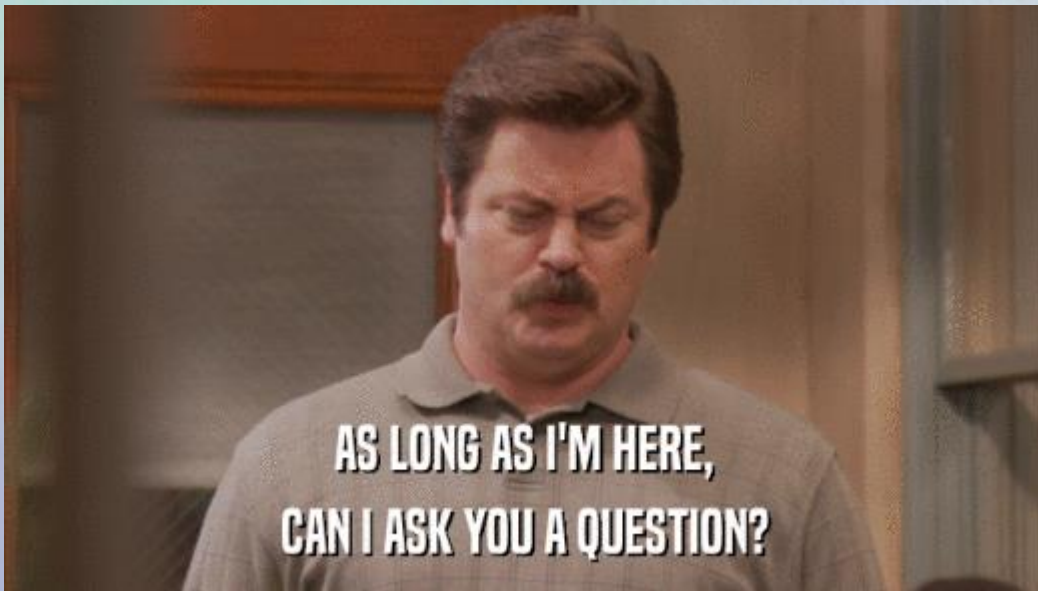

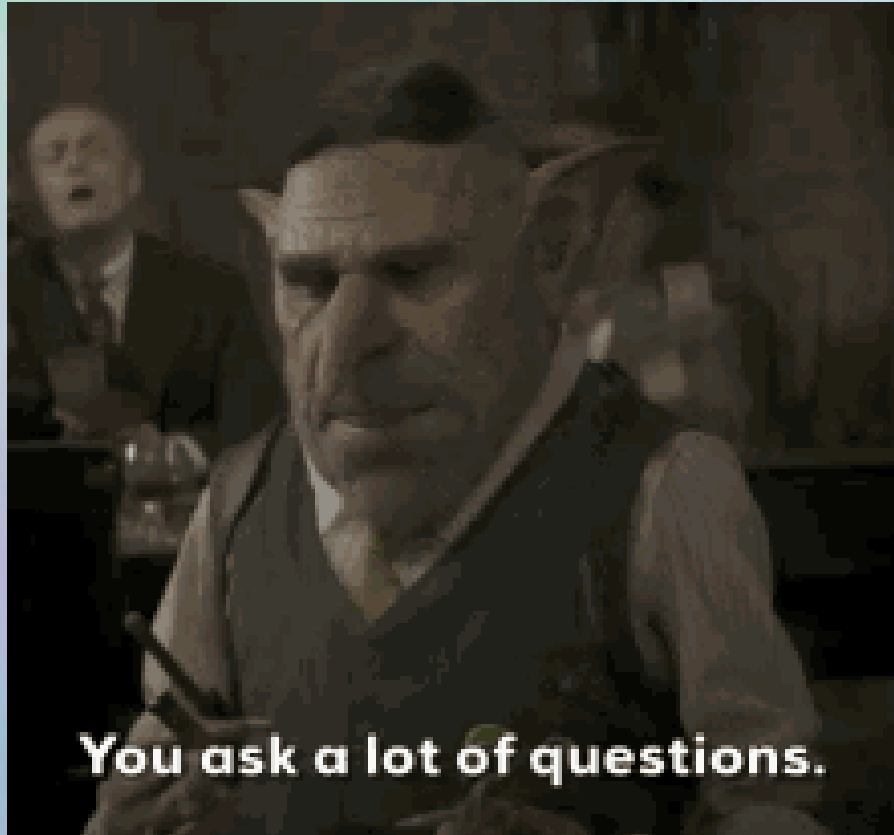


3. Breathing exercises for all in class to help with overwhelm and anxiety -

4. Training in neurodiverse behaviours and how to deal with this for all staff.

Teachers and PSAs *are* trained to various degrees on Neurodivergence. If a child has ND Identification/Diagnosis, class teacher and the Team Around the Child will ensure they have the knowledge and understanding to support the needs of that child.

(If you know one child with ASD, you know one child with ASD.)
